


An Introduction of Japan • Central Tottori Area's Main Tourist Destinations




Shirakabe Dozogun • Akagawara



A quiet street featuring traditional storehouses and merchant homes. Featuring traditional Japanese architecture, it has been selected as a protected location. Walking along these few hundred year old historic buildings will take one back in time. Gift shops and cafes are also available.

Misasa Hot Spring

Map Number 2 Misasa Town



Boasting a history of more than 800 years, Misasa Hot Spring is the representative hot spring of the San-in region, and is well known throughout Japan. Lined with small and large Japanese inns, one can experience the noted elegance of an old onsen town.

Hawai Hot Spring

Map Number 5 Yurihama Town

A hot spring to the west of Lake Togo. The streets, lined with various Japanese inns, protrude into the lake, and at night appears to be a cruise ship floating on the water's surface. One can enjoy visiting the four foot springs (free) in the area as well.



Togo Hot Spring

A hot spring located on the southern shore of the lake. From the inn, one can admire an intimate view of the lake. The spring water is about 70 degrees, and foot springs (free), and spring-boiled eggs are quite popular. The spring is very close to the JR Matsuzaki station and the Chinese Garden: Enchoen.



Sekigane Hot Spring


Map Number 4 Kurayoshi City Sekigane Town

Set in a gorge in the Chugoku mountain range, the Sekigane hot spring is relaxing and quiet. The hot spring was said to be discovered 1200 years ago, and has a long history. Because of the beauty of the hot water, it is also called "Silver Springs".

Central Tottori: Good Old Japan's Agricultural Area

Blessed with the sea, mountains, lakes, fields, sand dunes, and hot springs, the area is rich in natural variety. The area's farming, fishing, and mountain villages, as well as the traditional architecture and folk arts, the area's rich tradition display the region's vibrant culture.

Mt. Mitoku Sanbutsuji Temple • Nageiredo Hall



Mt. Mitoku has been used as a Buddhist place of training for over 1300 years. Mitoku has an abundance of cultural assets including national treasures and Nageiredo Hall, a magnificent piece of architecture built into the face of a cliff, and is known throughout Japan. To see the hall directly, it is necessary to climb the mountain. Currently, the site is under consideration to become a World Heritage site.

Lake Togo

Map Number 6 Yurihama Town



Lake Togo is Tottori's second largest lake, and quite close to the sea. The hot springs that gush forth from the bottom of the lake provide the water for Hawai and Togo hot springs alike. A designated prefectural nature park, Togo has a circumference of 12km and an area of 4 square kilometers. Having a mixture of both fresh and ocean water, this brackish lake serves as a treasure store for the local fishing industry.

Chinese Garden: Enchoen



Overlooking Lake Togo, Enchoen is one of the largest Chinese gardens in Japan. As a symbol of friendship between Tottori and China, the planning, and the gathering and manufacturing of materials all took place in China. With the availability of Chinese acrobatics and traditional Chinese clothing rental, one can feel the elegance of China.

Japan-Korea Friendship Park Hill of Wind

Commemorating friendship between Korea and Japan, the park was built to look like a park in Korea. Two times in the past, shipwrecked Koreans were rescued by Kotoura's fisherman. The park overlooks the sea, and Akasaki Port is nearby as well, thats market handles locally produced fish, vegetables, and fruit.

Hanamigata Cemetery



An ancient cemetery that runs along the shore with over 20,000 graves. Being 2 hectors large, a cemetery of this scale is extremely rare in Japan. A beautiful contrast to the ocean, the graveyard has recently been used as a filming location for movies

Mt. Senio (Daisen-Oki National Park)



A 615 meter tall mountain known for its breathtaking 100 meter tall cliff near the summit. A national park, hiking, cherry-blossoms, and admiring the spring and fall leaves make Senjo a popular destination. It is also an important historical landmark due to Emperor Godaigo's decision to use it as a battle ground about 700 years
