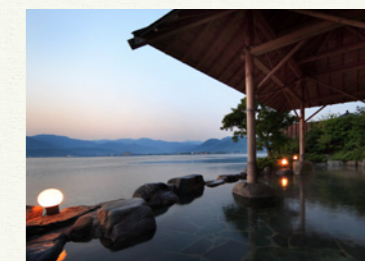

KURAYOSHI SHIRAKABE DOZOGUN

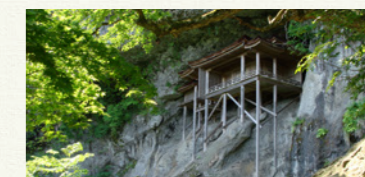
MISASA ONSEN
